Sub.- Need of a strong 'Accountability Law'.

Sir,

I need to submit you that there are numerous incidences of negligence ~~not~~ occurred in the country due to apathetic or *chalata hai* attitude of people. Some examples are given below-

1. Digging of bore well and falling down of a child in the open pipe (about 100-200 incidence per year).
2. Death of *safakaramchari* in a sewer line or man-hole (about 300-800 death per year).
3. Throat cut of a biker or child due to kite-thread (Chinese *maanjha*) -(150-600 incidence per year).
4. Releasing of current by electricity department during the repairing of the line and death of the employee on pole or line (250-600 death per year).
5. Non- reaching of ambulance or fire brigade due to narrow streets and encroachment by the residents on road.


These are some examples of negligence based on the news appeared in media.

Kindly make a strong law about the accountability of each activity, so that we can enjoy the life in sensible, responsive and accountable society.

We may test this issue during next Census-2021. Since the enumerator will collect information about vehicles, Acs, TVs, refrigerators, source of income, properties etc from each household. After the Census, we may randomly cross check the information given by the families and if some items are found extra in a family, then seize the item because the family had not reported it to the enumerator. I hope, this will lead to enhance the sense of accountability.
