Sir,

Its my moral duty to share with you some observations with a concrete suggestion about the attitude of civil servants towards COVID-19 pandemic. I have noticed in my workplace (Mohanlal Sukhadia University, Udaipur) in last 2-3 months that about half of civil servants do not follow the guidelines of COVID-19. Most of them keep the mask on chin or below the nose during interaction with others and social distancing is also not being followed. There are CCTV cameras in most of government offices. Whenever, a civil servant's test is declared Corona positive his/her 'COVID-19 compliance report' must be taken in a neutral way from all concerned colleagues, superiors and sub ordinates and if found the negligence of public servant then no quarantine leave is to be sanctioned and a disciplinary action must be taken.

We have spent more than 6 months with Corona and now no government can bear the load of undue expenditures due to negligence of people especially public servants. Please issue necessary orders in this regard.
