Sub.- Some suggestions for labour welfare.

Sir,

This is to apprise you that, about three dozen Ph.D. research scholars of various subjects (Faculty of Social Sciences including Geography and Law) of Mohanlal Sukhadia University, Udaipur visited the local labour- gathering place 'the Bekni pulia' and also observed and intercatced with daily job-seekers there. On behalf of all the scholars, I am submitting some suggestions for labour welfare-
1. Usually, 300-500 daily labourers from tribal areas and assemble at this place (Bekni Pulia, Udaipur) and there is no facility of toilets and drinking water here.
2. Exploitation of labourer by the contractors and middlemen is a coomon practice, so labour awareness camp may be organized periodically for all the stakeholders.
3. Welfare schemes of the Governemnt must be displayed here in Hindi with a detail process on a permanent sign board (NOT ON FLEX BOARD PLEASE).

A detail report may also be sent after full feedback from the scholars.
