Sir,

First of all, I congratulate and render the thanks, on behalf of entire residents of Jaipur to CM sir, UDH Dept. and RHB for developing a nice park in Mansarovar.

May kindly consider the following suggestions for the said park-

1. The park has a big geographical area however there is no shed available to have a stop during sudden raining and scorching hot season.

2. There must be a banyan tree (Bargad) in the park to make it more meaningful.

3. Flex banners must be replaced by permanent iron sheeted and painted display boards.

4. Please make an entry in the park with a nominal fee and a monthly paid pass to daily visitors. Similarly the parking facility too must be paid one. The point is that Indians do not respect and take care of free facilities. Moreover, the fee will support to the daily maintenance cost of the park.

5. Please repair the Aravali marg (parallel to the park) immediately, from Cambridge court school to New Sanganer Road. This road has become a dumping yard of broken cemented electric polls and other garbage.

6. Out -dated equipment kept in old workshop (towards B-2 bypass) may now be displayed properly in a small museum with info boards.
