Sub.- Suggestions for PM's Independence Day Speech to the Nation, for better India.

Sir,

I am submitting the following suggestions to see a better India in future-

1. I am a senior citizen and have also been a Professor of Public Administration. So, on the basis of my experiences I can say the governance mechanism is very poor in the country. Hardly few civil servants perform their duties effectively, enthusiastically and with desired commitment. Kindly introduce a **bill on Accountability of Civil Servants and Citizens** to hold responsible for each activity adversely affecting society and nation.
2. There are nearly 140 crore people in India. I do not think, we will be able to provide a proper -healthy diet to these people in future because a large part of our land is either barren or with the lack of irrigation resources. The fertile land of the country has been shrinking due to urbanization, industrialization and highways. Please think over '**Rivers -linking Project**' again. The paucity of drinking water and deepening of underground water (dark- zone) is a serious threat.
3. The second **Green Revolution and White Revolution** is an urgent need. The number of livestock is decreasing very fast and that is why synthetic milk and milk products are flooded in the market. Kindly open **Animal Hospital in each District and PHC at each Village Panchayat Level** immediately and launch a mega project on livestock welfare with full staff, proper buildings, vehicles and equipments. We may provide incentives to farmers and milk producers.
4. Please introduce a **bill on Population Control**. Considering the large portion of unemployed and also *unemployable* youth as demographic dividend is a myth.
5. Kindly link all information or data of a citizen in Aadhaar Card. This '**Citizen- Kundali**' must have information on his/her family, caste, category, moveable and immoveable property, residence, education, litigations, crimes, actions as a defaulter -citizen, character, employment , income, paid- tax, awards, punishments etc , so that a data base may help government agencies to control citizens and crimes effectively.
6. It is a very sad and shameful affair that most of the private educational institutions (especially colleges and universities) are not providing quality education and do not have ethical/ moral working-system. Similar situation is prevailing in private hospitals. Kindly prepare a **strong mechanism to control these private institutions**.
7. **Ethics and morality in each class must be a part of course/ syllabi** and it should be based on scientific temper and common sense.
8. It is evident that any law which makes a provision of 'no- bail' creates large number of fake cases (e.g-women harassment, atrocities with SC, ST etc). So there is an urgent need

to insert a clause in such laws that a **person who filed a wrong/fake case will face the legal action in reverse-party mode** and the term of punishment should be equal to earlier filed case or its clauses. All government facilities must be taken back from, these mis-users of the law.

9. The daily food cost of each convicted prisoner must be charged from his/her family (if family exists). No welfare State is supposed to feed criminals.
10. The punishment for the crimes like, rape, cheating with foreign visitors, adulteration in food items, leaking / disclosing question paper, cheating in examinations and defamation of any person must be equal to a murder.
11. A national law or public policy must be framed for the matters related with pet lovers, livestock owners and straw animals. Straw animals are going to be a serious issue for citizens' security and social harmony, as nearly 20 persons are losing their lives due to attack of straw animals, per day in India.
